General Description

The purpose of this class within the organization is to provide emergency medical services for Brunswick County during time with patients onsite and throughout transport to local emergency departments.

This class works under general supervision, independently developing work methods and sequences.

Duties and Responsibilities

The functions listed below are those that represent the majority of the time spent working in this class. Management may assign additional functions related to the type of work of the class as necessary.

Responds to emergency calls; provides basic life support emergency medical services; prepares and maintains detailed records associated with the service.

Responds to emergency calls; may assume command of an incident if on first arriving unit; determines the necessity of additional resources; administers emergency care; transports victims to emergency care facilities; maintains records and observes patient responses; identifies diagnostic signs which may require communications with medical facility for advice and direction; provides direct patient care as ordered; administers prescribed drugs under medical direction and performs defibrillations as required.

Checks and prepares equipment and supplies for treatment; cleans, disinfects and maintains medical equipment.

Performs vehicle fleet maintenance checks are performed daily.

Educates public in matters of health care and emergency situations, injury prevention and emergency situations.

Coordinates and performs housekeeping duties to EMS station.

Participates in continuing training and instruction program by individual study of technical material and attendance at scheduled drills and classes.

Performs related work as assigned.
